The Chair welcomed all present for the first course committee meeting of this semester (Sep 2017 – Jan 2018). There was a formal introduction of all Class Representatives (CRs) and English staff.

The Chair emphasized the importance of this forum and urged student representatives to raise both their concerns and points about which they were happy to the forum. The discussions in this forum will enable the college to serve students better.

Minutes of previous meeting:

The Chair read through the minutes of the previous course committee meeting held on 10th April 2017. As there were no issues arising, the Chair confirmed the minutes.

Class Representatives presented the following points for discussion:

S/No.	Class	A Concern raised by	Response/Action Taken
	Groups	students	
1.	F6	It was stated that some students attended the mathematics class and the Maths lecturer marked them absent.	The maths lecturer clarified that students are coming late to class. The College policy is that if students come after 15 minutes late to the class this will be considered as an absence. However, the student can present reasons to the faculty member outside of class, if there are exceptional reasons which should be taken into account. The HoF stated that students should be more responsible and try to attend the class on time.

1. ACADEMIC ISSUES:

2.	F3	Some students are not pleased with their timetables.	The timetables are designed carefully with both full and part time students in mind. If students are not happy with the timetables they can meet with the programme manager at the beginning of the semester, and present reasons for their issues. Students are always listened to, and changes may be made on a case by case basis.
	F1	Sunday's timetable is difficult for students and tiring for them.	All groups have a very similar timetable. It is the students' responsibility to adjust to life in college and attend their classes.
	F6	Timetable should be the same every day all week days because of Transport issues.	Different days will have slightly different timings. Regarding hostel transport, students need to talk to the Head of student service department if there are concerns with the bus timings.
3.	F3	Students are requesting BM lecturer to be more friendly with the students.	The BM lecturer assured students that he is friendly to all (male and female students), and will ensure that appropriate support and encouragement are given to all.
4.	2PTA	Students are requesting for support classes for mathematics. Mathematics topics are of high level.	The support session was scheduled between 3:00- 4:00p.m. Students can utilize the opportunity given by the lecturers. The level of Maths studied is appropriate for the level of secondary school graduates.
	1PTA	Require more practices on the Move page for mathematics.	Practice exams have already been uploaded on the MOVE page.
	2PTB	It's better to review Maths homework during class time.	During class time it's very difficult to review the homework because the class is just one hour long. Students were requested to meet lecturers during their office hours to discuss issues of concern with their homework.

5.	F20	In the IT module, students need more practical experience rather than theory.	Students were advised that the IT Module contained both theory and practical. Action: The lecturer was advised to clarify with the students what, exactly, the practical requirements were.
6.	F20 2PTB	Students need extra time for Academic Writing and Math Exams. Need more time for Applied Mathematics exams.	More time will not be considered for the math exams, unless there is an observable trend in students not being able to complete the exam. Instead more support classes can be provided to the students. Action: Support classes will be arranged 3:00-4:00p.m for part time students.
7.	1PTA	Students require more practice in the BM and VC Modules.	More quizzes have been uploaded for VC modules on the MOVE Page. More Math practice exams have been uploaded on the Move page every week. The chair requested students to talk directly to their lecturers in the case of specific concerns.
8.	F23/F6	Some students said it was difficult to understand the language of the Maths lecturer.	Different lecturers have different accents, and this is part of life in a multilingual / multicultural environment. If students are not able to understand they can ask lecturers to clarify, or speak more slowly in class.
		Classroom need to be changed to larger class F6	Classroom capacity is normally 30 and it will fit the number of students. In the future if the numbers are more we will use larger rooms.
		Two lecturers teaching one module can be a problem for students' understanding.	It was stated that the only way for tutor teaching load planning to be effective was to share some modules. It was also stated that if there are any specific problems

			with these arrangements students should voice these to the PM, DoS or HoF, and a solution found to the issue.
9.	2PTB	The Academic Reading book is difficult.	The Academic Reading books will probably be changed next Academic year, because of the level of difficulty of some of the texts.

2. ANY OTHER BUSINESS:

- ✓ All Students must inform their respective groups about the discussion of the course committee meetings.
- The students should take advantage of the forums to express their concerns.
 These issues will be communicated and the college will take necessary actions on time.
- ✓ Students were encouraged to participate in the Foundation Fest which will be held on December 13, 2017. Different kinds of activities such as Art work, spellbee, food court, football match and tug of war will be arranged.
