 - o The brand?
- 4. The Competition
 - o Is it a winning idea? Why?
 - o How will you market your idea (what is your marketing plan)?
 - > How attractive is it to customers?
 - o Who is in this market already?
- 5. Profit potential:
 - o Is it profitable?
 - o How much will it cost to set up? What investments are required?

Continuation Sheet

- What are your profit projections for the first: 6 months, 1 year and 5 years?
- 6. The Business Plan: What skills, experience or knowledge make your business idea likely to succeed?

The following criteria will be considered by the judges:

- Is the idea new or unique?
- · Can it be sold?
- · Will it be sustainable?
- Is it realistic, feasible and practical?

Stage 2: Shortlisting

Five short-listed candidates will be asked to present their ideas to a panel of judges in the form of a business plan.
