The Chair emphasized the importance of the forum and requested student representatives to raise their concerns in addition to points about which they were happy in the forum. The discussions in this forum will enable the college to serve students better.

Minutes of previous meeting:

The Chair read through the minutes of the previous course committee meeting held on 26th March 2018. As there were no issues arising, the Chair confirmed the minutes.

Class Representatives presented the following points for discussion:

1. ACADEMIC ISSUES:

S/No.	Class Groups	A Concern raised by	Response/Action Taken

1.	F4	Student requested a change in timetable and one of the lecturer.	HoF said that the detailed problem regarding the timetable needs to be given and only then can it be resolved. Action: HoF will speak to the lecturer after the meeting.
2.	F3	Students are happy with the all the lecturers, but Math class is crowded.	Programme manager reported that the normal capacity of the class is 30. If there is a specific problem with a particular room the room can be changed.
3.	F3	Timetable is very full	The HoF confirmed that the Foundation has a 24 hour weekly teaching plan. This is in accord with ministry expectations.
4.	F1	Students request for listening room.	The HoF noted that S106 is currently free for students to use as they wish. Students can decide or plan what would be best way to innovate this room. Action: Student voice along with with LTC and Faculty should be heard with regards to the future of S106.
5.	F1	Need to have more activities in the Books.	The number of activities varies within the books. More detailed comments need to be given to consider this issue in more detail, and respond

		appropriately.	
6.	1PTA/F22/2PTA	S108 and S109 chairs are uncomfortable.	It was recently noted in an AMT meeting that the chairs of the mentioned rooms will be upgraded.
7.	2PTB	Projector point is not clear and some of the positions need to be fixed.	Action: To contact IT support to check the projector focus and position in this rooms.i.e S211 and S205. However, different lecturers prefer different positions (centre or to the side) and so this issue is more complicated than might be thought.
8.	1PTA	Students want to use calculator in the maths exams.	The module lecturer stated that it is a ministry requirement that in semester one calculators should not be used in exams.
9.	F7	Tuesday/Wednesday timetable needs to be changed. Problem with one hour break.	The Chair requested the PM to look into the issue will and try to ensure sufficient breaks are given.
10.	F22	Students don't want two lecturers to teach one module. Students will get confused because of the same topic taught by first lecturer will repeated by second lecturer.	HoF stressed that generally, faculty do not split a module between two lecturers. However this is sometimes necessary. Action: HoF will request DOS to discuss with lecturers of shared modules and ensure the best strategies for handling shared modules are adhered to.
11.	F21	They need to change the IT2 book to make it easier.	The first few weeks are theoretical. Later on there is a significant practical component.
12.	F7	Students requested more classes for IT.	The module lecturers reported that now we have three hours IT classes per week (compared to the previous 2). The material can be managed within this time.

2. ANY OTHER BUSINESS:

✓ HoF stated that if students have any issues they can directly contact the lecturers or they can meet the HoF.

- ✓ All the students were informed about the foundation fest which is going to take place on December 4, 2018. Students were encouraged to participate in different activities organized by the team.
- ✓ All Students should inform their respective groups about the discussion of the course committee meetings.
- ✓ The students should take advantage of the forums to express their concerns.
